Preschool Aged School-Year Program

(For children ages 3 to Pre-K)

New for the 2017/18 school year, we will be holding this program as two-15 week sessions. Registration for the winter/spring session will take place starting in November. Those enrolled in the fall session are not guaranteed a spot in the winter/spring session. This program is designed to be a school year long program. Children enrolling in only the winter/spring session will have missed out on 15 weeks of the beginning curriculum. For the most successful experience for your child, we suggest taking both sessions of the program.

Throughout this dynamic educational and socialization program, your child will be engaged in developmentally appropriate activities that will stimulate each child's social/emotional, physical, creative and cognitive development. Children will have fun while learning through play, exploration, stories, crafts and music. This program will introduce students to basic skills such as:

- counting by 1's, 5's, and 10's
- letter recognition and sounds
- fine motor skills
- rhyming
- sequencing patterning
- science activities
- color and shape recognition
- creative drama
- reading readiness
- music and movement
- encourage language & thinking skills

There are two program opportunities; **Little Learners** for children who are ages 3 & 4 and **Jump Start to Kindergarten** for children ages 3^{1/2} to Pre-K. Each 15-week session provides new and exciting educational opportunities. Fall session starts in September and runs through December, winter/spring session starts in January and runs through May. Children must be the required age by September 1 to enroll for the fall session and January 1 to enroll for the winter session.

With these classes, we also utilize the parents as classroom helpers which allows you to interact with your child in their classroom experience. We request you volunteer at least one time per session. We also request that the children bring a snack once per session. Please inform us of any allergies when registering your child. Please also note that we are not able to administer any medicines to children other than inhalers and Epi-pens. Children who attend these classes must also be potty trained and able to use the washroom with minimal assistance.
