



**CITY OF MUSKEGO**  
**BAY LANE DRIVE RECONSTRUCTION**  
**CONSTRUCTION STATUS AND SCHEDULE**

Dear Resident of Bay Lane Drive:

Our project consultant (raSmith) is in the process of completing the plans for the reconstruction of Bay Lane Drive, between Woods Road and Janesville Road. The road work will be publically bid in March and we anticipate construction to begin in May of 2019 and be completed in September of 2019. Work on public utilities, tree/brush clearing and water main installation in the northerly portion of the project area may start in March, prior to the road work. Plan modifications were made based on the September 10, 2018 public information meeting and are briefly summarized below.

- Existing alignment to remain as it is presently.
- **Woods Road to Bridgeport Way (east)** - Roadway cross section will remain rural with gravel shoulders; ditches to remain on west side of the roadway; shallow ditches will be created along the east side of the roadway with a connection to a storm sewer that will be placed under a proposed 6-foot wide paved path adjacent to the front property lines. A storm water quality facility will be constructed on vacant lands at the southeast corner of Woods Road and Bay Lane Drive.
- **Bridgeport Way (east) to Hilltop Drive** - Roadway will not be widened to the east (southbound lane) for a parking/bypass lane; roadway will be widened to the west to accommodate a by-pass lane; curb and gutter installed on both sides; 6-foot asphalt path will continue on the east side of the roadway to the north; there will be no connection between Bay Lane Drive and Bellview Drive.
- **Hilltop Drive to Janesville Road** - Roadway cross section will remain rural (gravel shoulders and ditches on both sides); a 6-foot wide path will be installed on the east side of the roadway and be located approximately nine (9) feet off the roadway pavement; work in the section will include installation of storm sewer between the roadway and the asphalt path.
- **Northerly school entrances** - new curb and gutter and pavement is planned to create defined entrance and exit drives separated by green space.

During construction, the City will have a project site representative available to address resident concerns. Construction updates will be posted to the City of Muskego website.
