Leprechaun's gold is hidden throughout the Library! Find five golden coins and bring them to the Reference Desk for a piece of candy.

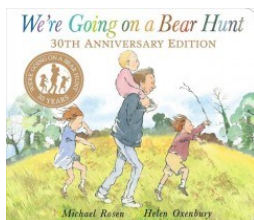


Family Picturebook Brunch

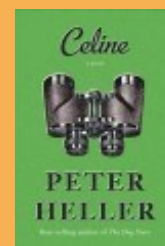

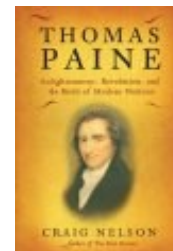
