

Frequently Asked Questions

Are all titles available for Kindle?

Almost all titles in our digital collection are available in Kindle format, but some may not be. You can limit your search to only Kindle books using step 3 under finding books in the instructions.

How many books can I check out at once?

10 item check out limit.

You may now place holds on Overdrive items from the CAFÉ catalog. These holds do count towards the limit of holds allowed on your library card (25) and on Overdrive (10). Items checked out and placed on hold through either catalog will show up on your library card account.

How do I bookmark my page?

There is no need for bookmarks, when you leave a book or exit the app it will remember that page the next time you open the book.

How long is the lending period?

The default is set at 7 days but you may be able to choose up to 21 days in your account settings.

What happens when that time is up?

When the lending period end, the eBook link will expire. You don't need to return the book, however you can return it at amazon.com/manageyourkindle

Can I renew items?

Yes, log in to your account using the dbooks.wplc.info page and select loans under your account settings to get renewal options.

What is my pin number?

Contact your library for your pin number.

1. Visit the **Amazon App Store**
2. Search for **Overdrive**
3. **Install** the **Overdrive** app

SETTING UP THE APP

1. **Sign Up** for an Overdrive account using your Library card or sign in if you have used Overdrive in the past
2. Enter Muskego into the Search box and choose **Bridges Library System—Muskego** from the list after hitting Go
3. Choose **Bridges Library System** from the dropdown list
4. **Enter library card number**
(CAFE is included as part of the card number)
5. **Enter PIN**
(please call your library if you do not know your PIN)
6. You will be asked to **Add a Library** which can be done by searching library name or zip code
7. Choose **Bridges Library System—Muskego** to get access to the Wisconsin Public Library Consortium's digital books
8. Click **Add a title** to start downloading our digital eBooks and Audiobooks

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FINDING BOOKS

1. Click in the **Search** box next to the magnifying glass to search for title or author
2. Click the three lines in the upper right corner to open the menu to browse by subject or collection
3. Use the **Filters** dropdown menu to limit search parameters (e.g. available now, Kindle)
4. The format will be listed below the book cover as eBook or Audiobook
5. When you find a title you are interested in you can **Borrow** the book if it is available now or **Place a Hold** if it is checked out and you will get an email when it is available
6. When you click **Borrow** it will ask you to sign in with your library card information if you have not done so
7. The word borrow will now be replaced with the option to go to loans

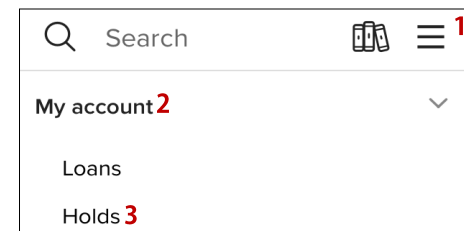
DOWNLOADING eBooks

1. Click **Go to Loans** to see items you have checked out
2. Click **Read Now With Kindle** to download the book to your device
3. You will be redirected to [amazon.com](https://www.amazon.com)
4. Click **Get Library Book** after making sure that your 'deliver to' dropdown is set to the name of your Fire device
5. **eBook** titles will appear on the **Home** screen of your Fire
6. **Audiobooks** will be on the **Bookshelf** page inside the Overdrive app

ADDITIONAL TIPS...

Checking Your Holds

1. While on the Wisconsin Digital Library page click the three lines in the upper right corner to open the menu
2. Click on **My Account** and then **Holds** to see your place in the holds list
3. You can also suspend and remove holds from this page



Changing the lending period

1. Log into your account on the website dbooks.wplc.info using your library card and PIN number
2. In the top right corner click **Account**
3. In the right hand column click **Settings**
4. In the center of the page are options for different lending periods
*High demand titles have a default check out of 14 days
