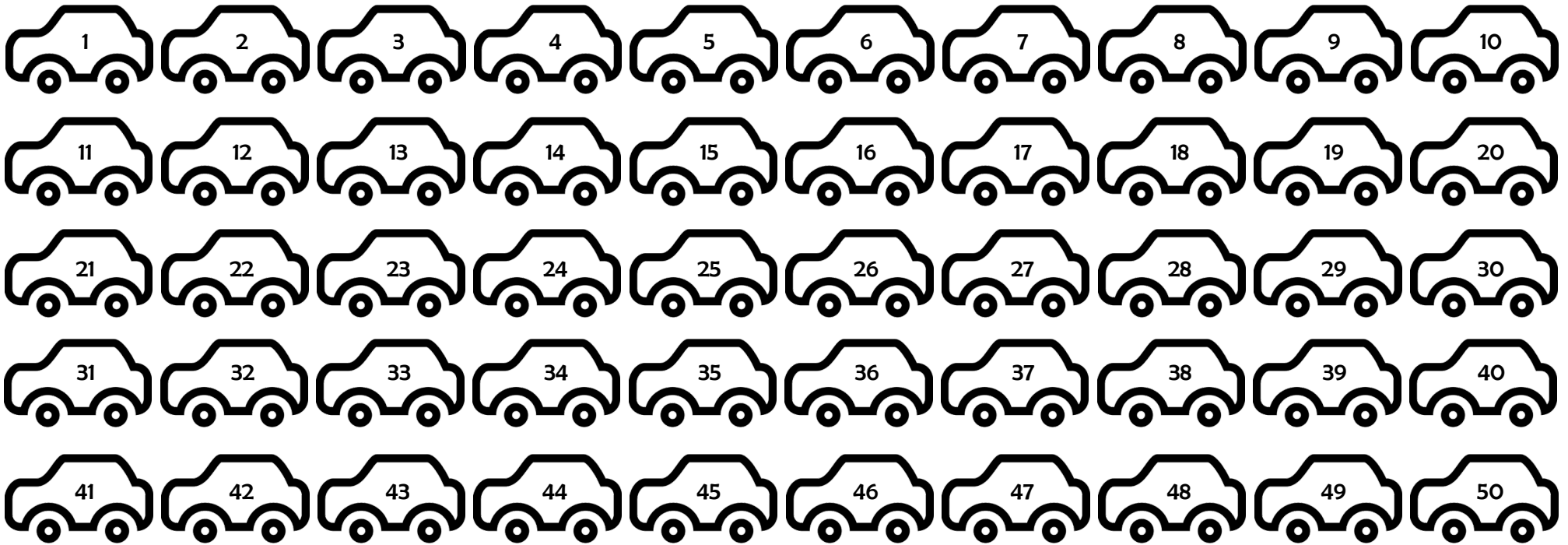




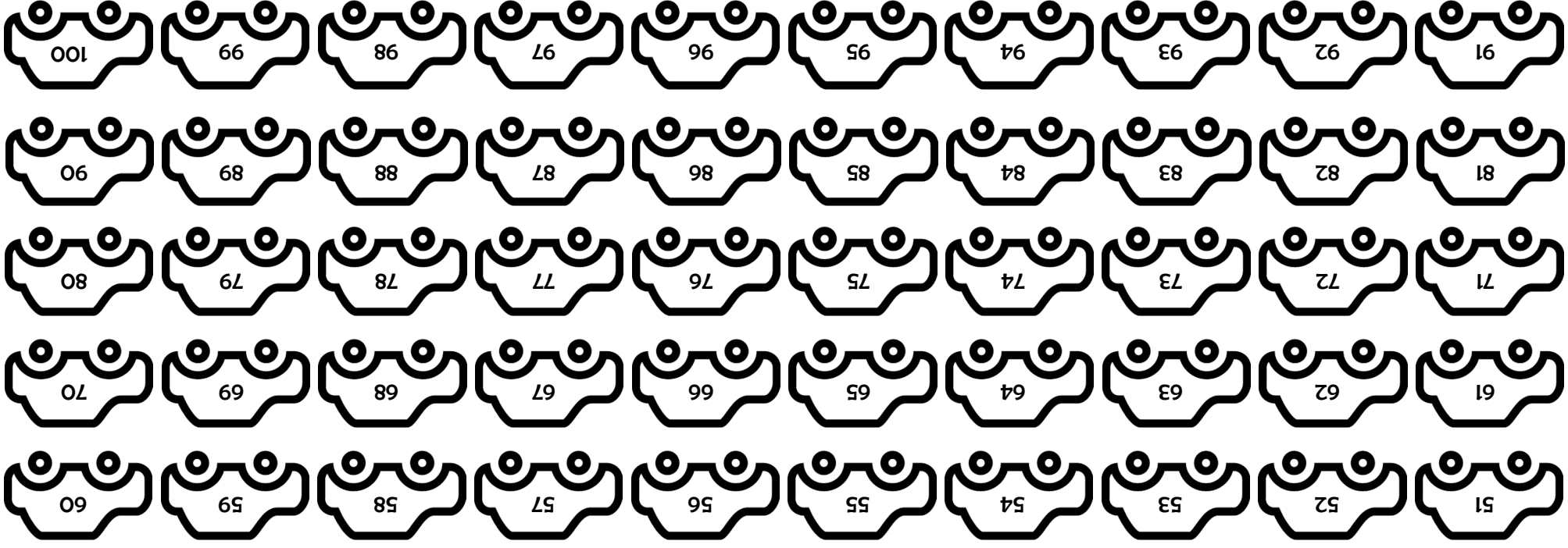
Road to Reading
