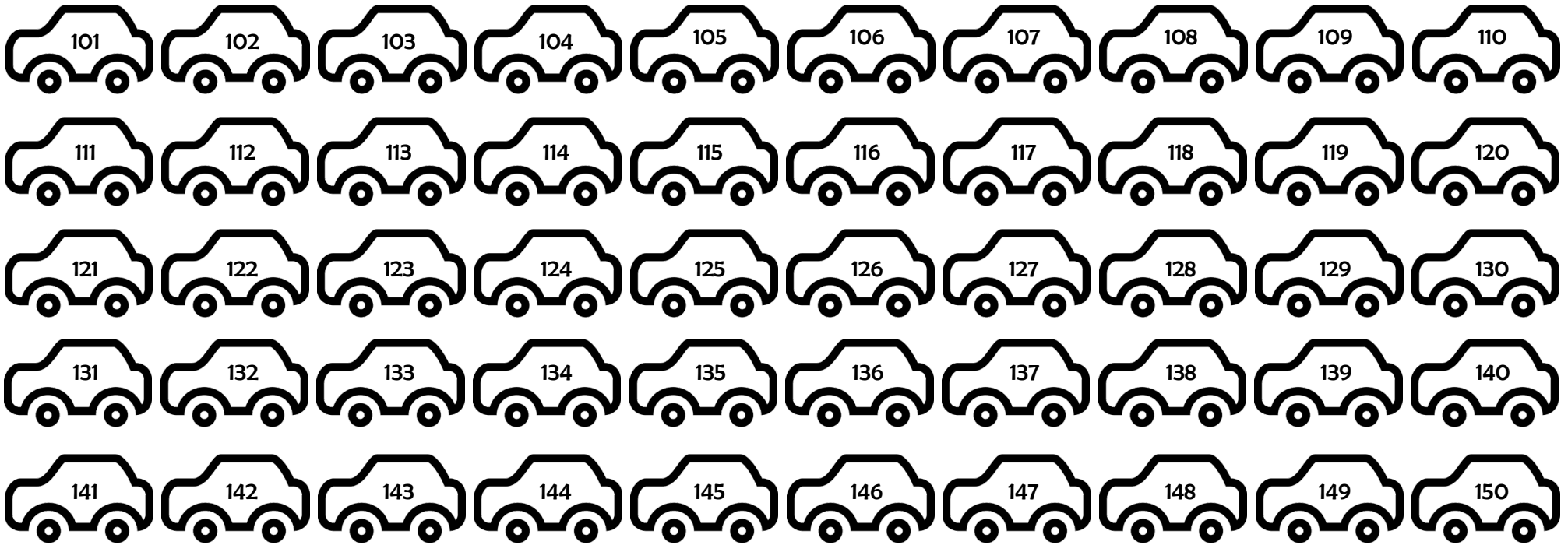




# Road to Reading

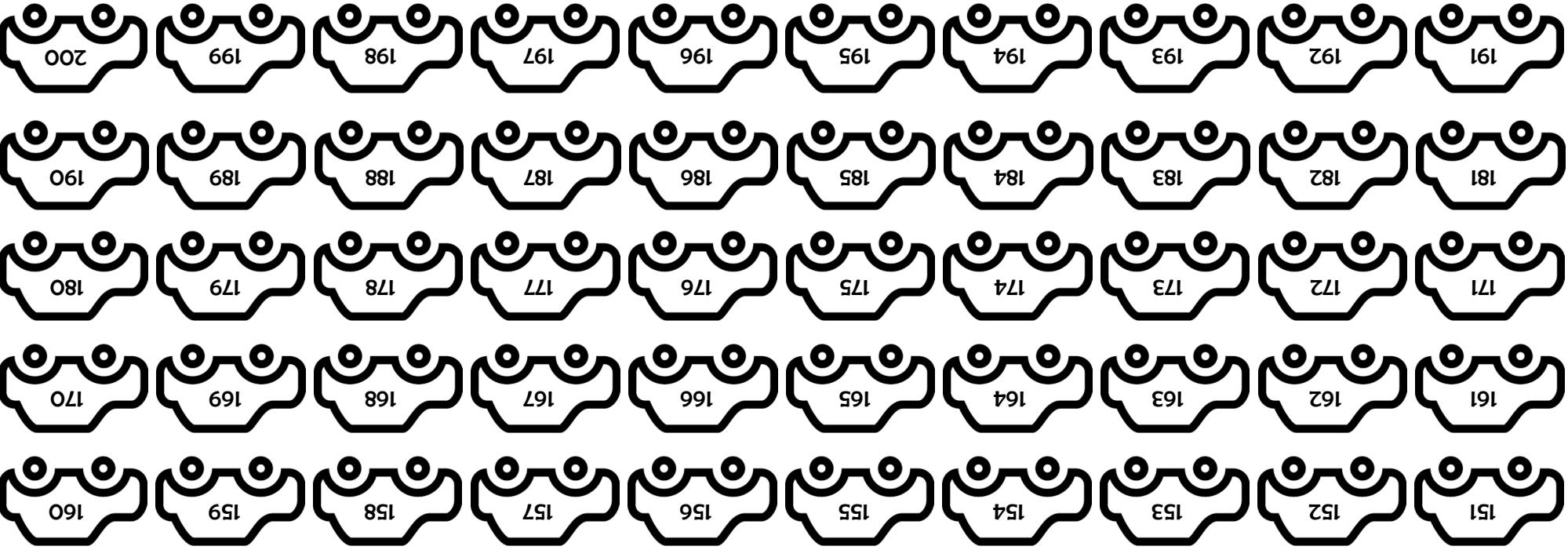

**Write...**  
the word CAR on a big piece of paper. Use the letters like roads and trace them with cars, boats, or whatever transportation toys you have!

**Play...**  
Red Light, Green Light. Try to freeze and hold really still when the light is red, then go-go-go when it's green!
