**ORDER REGARDING EMERGENCY TEMPORARY MEASURES**

The City of Muskego Municipal Court by this Order provides procedures and direction for proceedings in the courtroom during the next several weeks. The guidelines are emergency and temporary measures ONLY and are effective until further order of the Court.

The World Health Organization declared a global pandemic of COVID-19 due to widespread human infection. This Court is committed to service and to the well-being of the public. During the current COVID-19/Coronavirus pandemic and present outbreak of the omicron variant, this Court seeks to protect the health and safety of the litigants, court staff, security, attorneys, and other participants in court proceedings.

The City of Muskego Municipal Court **HEREBY ORDERS:** the City of Muskego Municipal Court office will remain open and court proceedings will remain in person. However, until further notice, face masks that cover the mouth and nose are required of everyone appearing in court, regardless of vaccination status. Face masks will be available at court for use by those appearing in courtroom proceedings. If a litigant is unable to wear a mask or refuses, the Court will reschedule the litigant's court appearance to a later date when this Order is no longer in effect. Anyone who has been exposed to COVID or who is feeling ill should not come to court in person, but should instead contact the Clerk of Courts to discuss a safer option to enter his/her plea.
