

Question	Answer
Do we have to send in training for chiefs or do we do that ourselves?	The clerk tracks the training taken by their election workers. It does not have to be reported to the WEC.
Training for Deputy Clerks also? I have a new person I'm trying to get her hours in.	Deputy clerks are not required by state law to take training, but we will track it if they choose to pursue certification.
What if the student ID does not have an expiration date?	Then it is not a valid form of photo ID. It must have an expiration date to be used for photo ID, even if it can be expired.
Can the proof of enrollment be on their phone?	Yes.
If a voter is registered without a hyphenated name, but their driver license is hyphenated we can accept that as valid photo ID?	A hyphenated name reasonably conforms to the name on the poll list.
Can you address how to handle "reasonably resembles" the elector in relation to trans gender individuals? This was an issue in our city during a recent election.	Election inspectors should be trained to look for a 'reasonable resemblance' such as eyes, face shape, etc. If they are not sure, they should contact the clerk or our office.
Yes, these guides are printed in color, laminated and posted everywhere in my polling place! Great tip!	Thanks, we are happy you find them helpful!
Are you saying spouses of Military must show ID if they appear at the polling place?	Yes, anyone voting in person – except for confidential voters – must provide photo ID. This includes military voters, their spouses and dependents.
Can a military or overseas voter submit an absentee ballot application as indefinitely confined? (I understand indefinitely confined are not required to submit photo id; just checking.)	There is no law against it.
What about passports for photo ID on an absentee ballot request. Is that acceptable?	A passport book or card is acceptable photo ID.
Indefinitely confined voters, I thought the request was valid unless they did not return ballot of general?	Yes, that is correct, unless they don't return a ballot for an April, November or Special Election. The clerk must send the 30-day letter within five days of the election informing the voter they must respond to stay on the list.
What if they refuse to show their ID during absentee voting? Can you tell them they will need to go to the polls on Election Day then?	If a voter refuses to show a photo ID during in-person absentee voting, they do not receive a ballot.

<p>But what if the voter has NO possibility of providing a photo ID before the provisional ballot expires.</p>	<p>They have to provide one. The voter should investigate the IDPP option available at the WI DMV.</p>
<p>Can you put up a copy of the photo ID picture guide by the poll books for inspectors to check?</p>	<p>Yes!</p>
<p>If you know the person, do they still have to state their name and address?</p>	<p>Yes, it's for the benefit of others as voting is a public process.</p>
<p>How do you handle a voter who does not have a photo id because it's against their religion, i.e. Amish?</p>	<p>There is a photo ID that does not require a picture or they can go through the IDPP process.</p>
<p>Please clarify page 11 Military is exempt (home or away) page13, in-person voting must provide including military. Seems conflicting. Military at home will probably vote in person.</p>	<p>Military voters are exempt from providing Photo ID if they are voting by absentee ballot by mail. If they are casting their ballot in-person they still need to show a photo ID.</p>
<p>if we have a chief that wants to start February 2022 or inspector, can they still work the 2022 term if get their training</p>	<p>Yes, they need to take the Baseline CIT class for certification and complete the remaining hours for a total of six hours, by the end of the term or December 31, 2023.</p>
<p>Do we need to do anything to list this training webinar in our record as I assume you have our registration?</p>	<p>All webinars that you attend, including this one, still need to be reported to us through the training form. We do not automatically enter training for webinar attendees.</p>
<p>I have reached my 6 hours, so can I use the two webinars I have watched this year for 2022-2023</p>	<p>The training you take during the 2021-2022 term recertify you for the 2022-2023 term. Any hours over 6 cannot be accrued to the 2024-2025 term.</p>
<p>If a Photo Id on file expires when a voter changes name and/or address, how does it work in WisVote if the photo is included in the voter record? When you update a registration in WisVote, does that automatically uncheck the box that photo ID has been provided and does it inactivate the photo record on file?</p> <p>How does it work in MyVote if a voter changes an address and previously had a Photo ID on file; and also requests an absentee ballot. Does the system “know” to require the voter to upload a new Photo ID prior to the absentee request going through?</p>	<p>Please contact the Help Desk and ask for a WisVote specialist., If someone has already provided a photo ID with an absentee application and they have not/do not need to update their registration ,the copy of the photo ID will still be acceptable even if expired. Once someone updates their registration either through MyVote or by mailing in a new registration, WisVote will automatically deactivate the photo ID for the new registration</p>

<p>My UWGB training shows 8.5 hours of Election training but the County only is showing 1 hr. for me . They got that from WEC.</p>	<p>Did you report your training to us? If not, we do not have a record of it.</p>
<p>Are we able to see trainings our election inspectors do complete?</p>	<p>No, but your inspectors who take training in The Learning Center are issued badges when they complete a training module.</p>

Is there someone I can email about that problem so that it can get checked? Thanks</p>	<p>I have brought it to the attention of the training who manages The Learning Center. You report your training to us and do not need supporting documentation.</p>
<p>Can I use the Oct 29 and 11/10 webinars for my 2022-2023 training requirements?</p>	<p>Yes.</p>
<p>Can a POA sign the certificate envelope for an elector?</p>	<p>An assistor may sign for a voter in the section for this use. It does not have to be a POA.</p>
<p>My HINDI number is incorrect on the training report.</p>	<p>Your HINDI number for the Department of Administration may be different than your HINDI number for elections. Please contact Allison regarding this.</p>
<p>Is it my responsibility as a chief to upload the training record to you or is it up to the City clerks?</p>	<p>Your training is tracked by your municipal clerk.</p>
