To celebrate the coming of summer, the Muskego Public Library is hosting a bookmark design contest featuring a garden theme. Entry forms are available to download and print. Printed forms are available at the reference desk. **Entries are accepted through April 24, 2021.**

- One entry per person.
- Winners will be chosen in three categories:
 - Kids in grades K-6
 - Teens in grades 7-12
 - Adults
- Entries will only be considered if this form has been completed and signed. A parent or guardian must sign for a minor.
- Completed forms can be returned to the reference desk or emailed to reference@cityofmuskego.org before 5pm on Saturday April 24, 2021. Make sure to return this form with your artwork!
- Your design must fit into the template on the back of this form to be considered.
- All artwork must be original. Nothing previously published will be accepted. Popular figures (e.g. Superman, Disney, etc.) cannot be considered due to copyright restrictions.
- We will accept drawings, paintings, collage, and photographs.
- Friends of the Muskego Public Library members will judge submissions for originality, adherence to the garden theme, and creativity. All judges' decisions are final. Winners will be notified on May 8th.
- Entries cannot be returned after judging. All artwork becomes the property of the Muskego Public Library.

Winning entries will show the first name of the artist and be printed and available at the Muskego Public Library in June.

If your concept requires painting, we highly recommend you paint onto your own paper while sticking to the same size. The full print area for the bookmark is 5.75H x 1.5W. We have magnified that by 1.75 for drawing purposes and will digitally shrink it down for the printer. This should allow you to fit in lots of detail without having to draw super tiny. Designs can be horizontal or vertical. For photographs, you can create a collage that fits on the bookmark or select a rectangular area of your piece, marked with an outline, when submitting digitally or in person. All digital images should be 300dpi or higher. The higher resolution, the better the quality of our final product!
